Melinda was a co-principal investigator on the research project, "Ka Awatea" – a case study of Maori student success in Rotorua. Melinda will share themes that emerged from the investigation and how these contribute to the success of Maori students. Further, her key note will share how this strengths-based research has influenced approaches to teaching and learning that is relevant to all.

Associate Professor Melinda Webber is the current Director of The Starpath Project. She spent four years working as a researcher on The Starpath Project from 2011-2014 identifying and addressing the barriers that prevent participation and success in degree-level education especially for Maori, Pacific, and other students from low socio-economic communities.
